Information zum Europäischen Sprachenportfolio

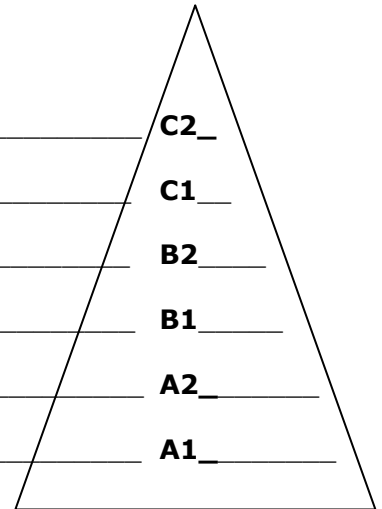
